The DeCYder 2013 A-Team Overview

The DeCYder, the 2013 tractor, was the second true functional utility tractor in the Cyclone Power Pullers lineup. Like the team's first utility style tractor, Cymon Sez, The DeCYder featured a tri-mode hydrostatic/hydro-mechanical transmission, known as the CyVT. The transmission also features a "true-neutral" mode, which eliminates troublesome neutral "creep". The DeCYder also featured functional accessory hydraulic ports, a three point hitch, a single Briggs & Stratton 31hp engine, and a revamped design to alleviate serviceability issues found in Cymon Sez. Marketed to the small hobby farmer, it was designed around utility and comfort. The 2 wheel drive setup gave The DeCYder increased maneuverability, while a redesigned operator station improved comfort. Lastly, The DeCYder featured a full floating rear axle design which increased serviceability and assisted in getting power to the ground with an open differential.

At competition, The DeCYder finished in 22nd place. Transmission control hurt the team's first two pull performances, which led to a less than satisfactory overall finish. A 7th place finish in the written report, 11th in the oral presentation and 11th place in manufacturability gave stepping stones to work from in the future.

The DeCYder will provide a strong base for the upcoming X-Team. The 2013 X-Team will be lead by Clayton Hamilton and Quenton Schneider. Testing the CyVT transmission and rear end are the top priorities of the team.

Cymon Sez 2012 X-Team Overview

Cymon Sez, the 2012 A-Team tractor, competed once again in Peoria this year. The X-Team did not fare any better than A-Team, as a broken belt during the pull led to a 10th place finish. Time constraints, electrical issues, and hydraulic issues plagued the X-Team, while they worked hard to present the best possible tractor at competition. A strengthened frame, improved operator station, and improved floorboards were some of the improvements made to the tractor throughout the year.

At competition the X Team saw success in both the written and oral presentations, achieving a 1st place finish in the written report and a 2nd place finish in the oral presentation. Despite some brake damage and a broken belt, Cymon Sez is back together and functioning. It will be pulling strong at the upcoming Sponsor pull. We are excited to see its full potential after the X-Team's improvements.
