Who are the Cyclone Power Pullers?

The Cyclone Power Pullers are a ¹/₄ scale tractor pulling team at Iowa State University. We are a multifunctional student organization that design, build, and test a tractor for the ASABE (American Society of Agricultural and Biological Engineers) ¹/₄ Scale Tractor Student Design Competition. The 2017 competition was held in Peoria, IL from June 1st – June 4th, and is organized to provide students with professional experience, education, and enjoyment.

What do team members gain?

Team members gain valuable practical experience in a variety of areas such as:

- Drivetrain System Design
- Tractor Performance
- Traction Force Analysis
- Weight Transfer

Throughout the year, team members also develop skills in leadership, communication, teamwork, and problem solving.

What is the design competition?

The competition consists of four categories: performance, oral presentation, design judging, and written design report. The teams must use a 31hp Briggs and Stratton engine and Titan 26x12-12 tires.

The rules forbid engine modifications and include safety requirements along with tractor size limitations, but the rest of the design is up to the team with the ultimate goal of out pulling the competition.
