#### 2018 A-Team Overview

After receiving a new set of rules for the 2018 competition, the team had to evaluate whether they should pursue the option of a skid steer or articulated type configuration. The team is planning to continue their development of an electrically driven transmission as used in the past two models. After learning from our mistakes, the team is ready for a fresh start and plans to continue to the Cyclone legacy of innovation and hard work.
